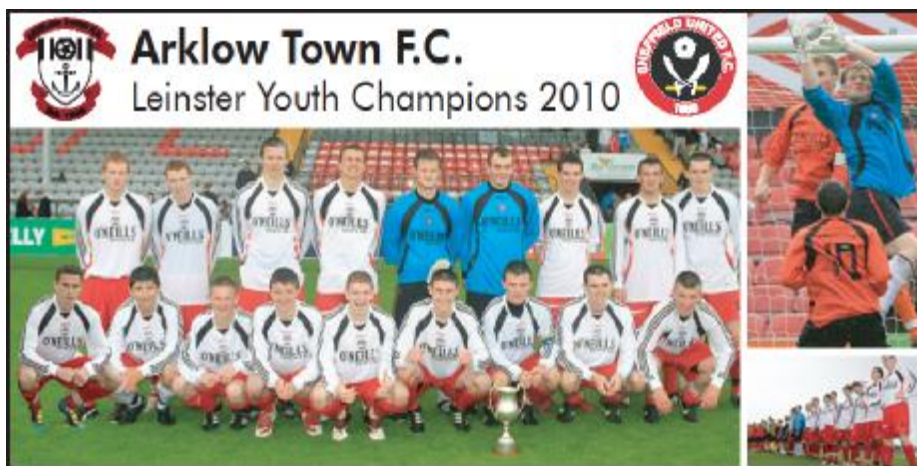

Arklow Town FC wants all players to enjoy their time with the Club and to this end all Players are asked to follow this Code of Conduct.

- ✓ Players should always show respect for their team mates, Managers, Coaches, Opponents and Officials.
- ✓ Players should arrive at training sessions and matches in good time and with the appropriate gear.
- ✓ Players should let Managers know as soon as possible if they are injured or sick and unable to attend a training session or game.
- ✓ Players must pay the annual club membership prior to the deadline date set by the Executive Committee and should pay their subs on a weekly basis without having to be asked. Any player who fails to pay their annual membership by the deadline date will not be permitted to play.
- ✓ Players should be willing to learn and improve. They should listen to Coaches and Managers and not distract others on the team.
- ✓ Players should always play to win but accept defeat and victory with the same spirit.
- ✓ Players should always shake hands with the opposing team after a game.
- ✓ Arklow Town FC will not tolerate bullying of any form. If a player feels he/she is being bullied they should feel safe to inform their Manager or, where applicable, the designated Children's Officer.



- ✓ The Club wants all players to enjoy playing football for Arklow Town FC. If a player is not, for whatever reason, they should feel free to tell their Manager or, where applicable, their parents or the designated Children's Officer.
- ✓ Players should be aware of the basic Ground Regulations and Pitch User Rules for venues run by Arklow Town FC and should ensure that they adhere to the regulations at all times.
- ✓ Players must never climb on or swing from a goalpost frame.
